In Memory of Christa McAuliffe

In 1991, Architects Group Limited completed a very high profile project in the Green Bay Area Public School District. The Christa McAuliffe Elementary School, named after the schoolteacher who died in the Challenger Space Shuttle explosion in 1986, is located on over eight acres of land in the Town of Bellevue, Wisconsin. The 45,770 square foot project designed with particular attention to energy conservation, houses 450 students in grades K-5 in this rural residential setting. This facility with its pitched concrete roofs covering over 80% of the building features 100% sustainable Vande Hey Raleigh concrete roof tile in the Early American Color Sequence.
